Subject:-Reassignment of Registration no./Change of Address/ Transfer of Ownership in respect of imported vehicles.

Sir,

It was brought to the attention of this Department by Regional Transport Officer, Darjeeling that owners of certain vehicles registered in Nepal were approaching him for having dual registration simultaneously in Darjeeling District as well as in Nepal, RTO, Darjeeling was instructed not to allow such dual registration in respect of any Motor Vehicles. In fact the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 do not permit such simultaneous dual registration in respect of any Motor Vehicle.

It has now been referred by RTO, Darjeeling that owners of certain vehicles, manufactured in India (like Maruti, Ambassador etc.) and having registration in Nepal, are approaching him to for allowing reassignment of registration no. /Change of Address/ Transfer of Ownership etc. and the RTO has, therefore, sought the clarification of this Department.

After careful consideration the following guidelines are being issued on the subject:-

1. Vehicle registered in Nepal, Bhutan or any country outside India, whether manufactured in India or not, and owned by an Indian National or by a Foreign National, shall be treated as an imported vehicle.
2. No change of ownership, change of address in the certificate of registration, reassignment of registration no. etc. in respect of imported vehicle shall be allowed by any registering authority within this state without obtaining clearance from Customs Authorities, Sales Tax Authorities

and such permission should be given only after the vehicles comply with the statutory obligations in this regard.

3. Such imported vehicles cannot ply for an indefinite period within this state without having transit certificates issued by the Indian Embassy in the corresponding country. In respect of vehicles registered in Bhutan, a detailed agreement is being executed by the Government of India and Government of Bhutan at our initiative. Whenever such imported vehicles are plying in India, possession of transit certificates issued by the Indian Embassy in the corresponding country should be insisted upon.
4. No vehicle can have dual registration no. under the provisions of MV Act. If any vehicle registered in Nepal has already been allotted dual registration no. by any Registering Authority in this State, the said registration no. should forthwith be cancelled/Recalled. The vehicle be treated as an imported vehicle for all purpose and its movement be regulated as per guidelines suggested above.

6. The following documents shall be produced by the applicant before registering authority -
 - i) Documents of the vehicle concerned including copy of certificate of registration,
 - ii) N.O.C. from the existing Registering authority
 - iii) Local address proof and
 - iv) Papers in support of his/her/their reason mentioned for change of address.
7. All such cases shall be placed before the Director, Public Vehicles Department, Kolkata or District Magistrate, as applicable, for approval.

Application not covered under above mentioned reason for change of address and/or assignment of new registration mark, shall be referred to the concerned RTA for taking necessary decision.

This shall take immediate effect.

State Government under sub-section 4 of the section 47 and section 65 of the Motor Vehicles Act 1988 the Governor has been pleased and direct to issue the following directions in the matter of effecting assignment of new registration mark in terms of section 47 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.

1. Application for change of residence or place of business and/or assignment of new registration mark in respect of Non-transport vehicle (excluding transfer of ownership) coming from outside of the State of West Bengal supported by adequate documentary evidence shall be made before the Registering authority within whose jurisdiction the applicant has new address of residence and the Registering Authority concerned shall examine the application for nothing change of address under section 49 of the motor vehicles Act 1988 and/or assignment of new registration mark under section 47 of the Motor vehicles Act 1988 read with Rule 54 of the Central Motor vehicles Rules, 1989 subject to all relevant provisions as laid down in the said Act and Rules.
2. The Registering authority shall ensure physical inspection of the vehicle.
3. Realisation of Taxes, fees with Fine / penalties as applicable shall be ensured before allowing change of address and/or assignment of new registration mark.
4. Applicant shall have to belong to any of the following categories –
 - i) Central Government Employee ii) State Government Employee, iii) Employee of Central Government Undertaking, iv) Employee of State Government-Undertaking, v) Employee of Corporate Sector Private Company, vi) Student and vii) Government Office / Government undertaking / Private Company / Registered Organisation.
5. Applicant shall have to qualify one of the following reasons for justifying prayer for change of address and/or assignment of new registration mark –
 - i) Transfer from other State to the State of West Bengal by concerned employer, ii) to settle permanently in the State of West Bengal after retirement / resignation from service in other State, iii) to join new assignment in West Bengal

ORDER

No Objection Certificate (NOC) is issued under Section 48 of the Motor Vehicles Acts, 1988 for the vehicles intended to move outside the jurisdiction of original Registering Authority by way of change of residence or transfer of ownership.

After obtaining NOC, the registered owner shall, within thirty days of the issue of NOC, report to the Registering Authority within whose jurisdiction the vehicle is to be registered as per provisions of Rule 54 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989.

Now, it is seen that after obtaining NOC, some registered owner failed to report before the Registering Authority to whom the NOC is issued and after passing away a good time sometime they approach the original Registering Authority for cancellation of the same.

Under the MV Act and Rule it is not clearly mentioned that NOC can be cancelled or cannot be cancelled .However no vehicle can remain without Registration for beyond thirty days and as because these vehicles were registered in West Bengal and the registered owners have requested for cancellation of the NOC, the State Government in the Transport Department has decided to regularize such cases under following terms & conditions :

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- a) Declaration in the form of an affidavit may be obtained from the registered owner of the vehicle regarding status , whereabouts of the vehicles during the period between the date on which NOC is issued and the date on which the vehicle owner approaches for cancellation of the NOC, that no case relating to breaking of law has been reported or is pending against the vehicle
- b) All the Government dues including tax and fines must be cleared.
- c) The registering Authority shall intimate to the concerned police authority on the cancellation of the NOC of the vehicle and the police authority shall inform if the vehicle in question has committed any crime / offence / illegal activities during the said period to the concerned Registering Authority.
- d) A fine must be paid in the following manner as mentioned in the Schedule below and permission be issued by the competent Authority as mentioned in the Schedule.

WHEREAS the Ministry of Shipping, Road Transport & Highways, Department of Road Transport & Highways, Government of India published Notification No. G.S.R. 84 (E) Date 9th. February, 2009 prescribing Bharat Stage-IV Emission norms and Bharat Stage-III Emission norms applicable as per Rule 115 of the Central Motor vehicles Rules, 1989 in India.

AND WHEREAS the Hon'ble Division Bench of Calcutta High Court in W.P. No. 2062 of 1999 passed orders on 30-03-2004 to control vehicular pollution.

AND WHEREAS for some time past the Government of West Bengal in the Transport Department had been issuing several directions and orders in the matter of control of vehicular pollution in and around the city of Kolkata as well as in the entire State of West Bengal.

AND WHEREAS several applications from many employees of Central / State Government, employees of Central / State Government Undertakings and Corporate Officials including such other individuals who have been posted or transferred or shifted to this State to join new assignment after resignation from service or who have changed their place of residence for staying in this State on transfer or after retirement from service in other States or other valid reasons, have been received by the Transport Department to accord permission for change of residence or place of business and/or assignment of new registration mark in respect of their existing vehicles registered in other states.

AND WHEREAS in relaxation of Emission Norms presently applicable in the State of West Bengal and the Transport Department has been considering such cases on case to case basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, in cancellation of all earlier orders issued in this regard and exercising powers conferred upon the

APPLICATION -

1. To apply before the concerned RTA office, where the vehicle stands registered at present.
2. To apply in prescribed format with fees.
3. To submit copies of RC, IC, TT, PUCC
4. To furnish signed agreement / contract with school/guardians – proforma annexed herewith for conformity.
5. Contract carriage permits may be given under the scheme as special case only and such conversion will not be referred to for any other claim or purpose. Permit as may be applied for, will be subject to strict observation of relevant directive / stipulations for carriage of school children and in particular to the directives of hon'ble supreme governing use of such school buses.
6. In case of applicants opting to use the same vehicles for caring of office staffs, then separate endorsement may be made on existing permits.
7. Existing permit holders may opt for extension / addition of area in the existing permits by payment of difference of fees for the same.

ISSUE OF OFFER LETTER:-

RTAs may authorize the Secretary, RTAs to process and allowing issuing offer letters subject to obtaining post-facto ratification by the RTA.

CONVERSION OF VEHICLES:-

1. On receipt of offer latter, application for conversion and remittance of due fees will be presented before registering authority.
2. The vehicles should be made ready and produce for inspection.
3. Approval will be given immediately after passing inspection.
4. If applied for, then tax paid against the non-transport vehicle, whether one-time or life time will be adjusted towards future payment, in terms of time or life-time will be adjusted towards future payments, in term of provisions of section 21(5) of the west Bengal additional tax and one- time tax on motor vehicles Act 1989, as transport vehicles from the date of approval of such conversion.

ISSUE OF PERMIT -

1. To apply for permanent Permit along with fees.
2. To submits copies of RC, CF, IC, TT, PUCC.
3. Contract carriage permits may be issue as afore said.

Sir / Madam,

Matters related to change of address and registration of old vehicles due to such change of address have been dealt with in this Department's Notification No. 781-WT/3M-21/2012 dated 08-03-2013, read with order No.1643-WT/3M-38/2013 dated 26-04-2013. However, confusions still persist while considering applications for change of address particularly for the Government employees on transfer / superannuation. The matter has been reviewed and considered by this Department and it has been felt that guidelines as contained in order No. 1643-WT/3M-38/2013 dated-26-04-2013 require further clarification and parital modification.

In the context of the above, I am directed to state that this Department has decided to settle the cases of change of address by the Registering Authorities in the following manner and until further direction :

1. Registered owners of non-transport vehicles who are or were Government employees of Central or State Governments or employees of Public sector undertakings of the Central or State Governments, upon migration to Kolkata, either on transfer or on superannuation, with valid NOC will have the change of address allowed if the said vehicles is BS-II complaint or above.
2. Registered owners of non-transport vehicles having residence or place of business within Kolkata Metropolitan Area will be allowed for change of address for such vehicle from one place to another place within the said area i.e. Kolkata Metropolitan Area irrespective of BS complaint status of such vehicles.

Subject:-Procedures to be followed for transfer of ownership and change of address of any vehicle within the state.

Sir,

This department has received representations of public facing difficulties in transactions related to applications for transfer of ownership of vehicles made in the office of the RA other than the office where the vehicle is registered and also sought clarifications on necessity of NOC, asked to be furnished by the RA, under the existing provisions of MV Act, 1988 & Rules made thereunder.

The matter was examined. It is a fact that at present in such cases, as a matter of practice, Registering Authorities process those applications for both 'Change of address' and 'Transfer of Ownership' of vehicle and ask for submission of 'No Objection Certificate (NOC) obtained from the Registering Authority where the vehicle is registered.

In terms of the provisions of MV Act, 1988 and Rules made thereunder the legal positions are as follows:

1. In terms of Section 48 of MV Act, 1988 NOC is only required for application for assignment of new registration mark of a vehicle brought from other state (Section 47(1) of the Act) and also in case of application for transfer of ownership of vehicle registered and sold in other State (Section 50 (1) (a) (ii) of the Act)
2. If the owner of a motor vehicle change his address, recorded in the certificate of registration of the vehicle, he shall apply for 'change of address' in terms of Section 49 of the Act and in the manner prescribed under Rule 59 of CMVR, 1989 No. NOC is required.
3. If a registered vehicle is sold, the transferee shall apply for 'transfer of ownership' to the RA under whose jurisdiction he resides or has his place of business, in terms of Section 50(1)(a)(i) of the Act and in the manner

MEMORENDUM

The issue of regulation of pool cars to contact carriages has been engaging attention of the state government for quite some time, now it has been decided that considering the compelling situation of ensuring road safety for all especially for the school children and monitoring status and condition of pool cars engaged in caring school children to and from their respective educational institution on regular basis, an "one time scheme for regulation of pool cars carrying school children to contract carriages" be formulated manners as detail below:

QUALIFICATION

Any vehicle that with the provisions laid down in this department order No. 764-WT/3M-10/2013 dated 08/03/2013 may be considered eligible provisionally for the scheme. In other words, it is clarified that all existing pool cars that carry school children and are registered on and after 01/01/2006 may be eligible for such regulation.

The scheme will operationalised with immediate effect and will remain open till 31/10/2016

SCOPE-

An application may opt for operation in one two or three districts or for the entire KMA or for entire West Bengal. All Regional Transport Authority (RTA) of the state upon consideration of application and compliance of relevant rule, may issue permits for the purpose of regularization of existing pool cars to contract carriages. Separate enabling notification will be issued in due course for issuing permit by RTAs.

PROCESSING -

Special cell may be created in all offices to fact track these cases and for coordination between various section of MV office. All concerned will be directed to priorities these cases, if necessary, offices may be kept open for this purpose on the first Saturday of the month till 31/10/2016. Instant operation of vhan or e-vhan for collection of taxes on such Saturday is however not allowed.

- d) All vehicles carrying school children must be subjected to annual tests for certificates of fitness and there shall be no exemption from this.
- e) All conditions mentioned by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in its relevant Judgement (as communicated by this department in its earlier communication No. 5139-WT/3M-34/2006) dated 31-12-2009) will continue to apply. A copy of the cumminication is enclosed.
- f) All vehicles shall have to qualify prevailing pollution norms applicable in the respective regions for the purpose of new registration, though conversion to contract Carriage may not be seen as new registration for this purpose.
- g) No vehicle with age of more than 10 years shall be entertained for new permit cases, though the old pending cases may be disposed of on the basis of certificates of fitness subject to Hon'ble Court's verdicts and Government's Orders, to the extent applicable.

An organised exercise may be launched from 11th March, 2013 for bringing the “Pool” vehicles in the ambit of regulatory control.

A detailed parawise compliance report shall be submitted by 10th April, 2013.

Section 49 of Act) shall not be attracted (to the contrary of the present practice). Further, only in case of transfer of ownership of a vehicle registered in other State (Section 50 (1) (a) (ii) of Act) NOC will be required.

Despite the above provisions of law the software of "Vahan" was designed customized in this State in a manner to follow the prevailing practices. However, on receipt of representations and considering the inconsistency, as directed by this department, NIC has already taken action to remove the process of requirement of NOC within the State for such cases in the software Transfer of Registration data from one RA to other in such cases has also been enabled for easy processing.

You are, therefore, requested to ensure that the provisions of law are followed accordingly by all the Registering Authority.

Dear Sir,

With reference to your No. PVD-10 (Con) dated 13-02-2013 on the subject mentioned above. I am directed to inform you that the State Government is keen to ensure that unauthorised and unpermitted cars are not allowed to carry school children on hiring basis. As such, all efforts must be made to ensure that "Pool cars" that are carrying school children on hiring basis in the city areas are brought within the ambit of regulatory legal controls, as provided in the various Acts and Rules of the land. A proactive drive may be taken to clear all pending cases that are lying undisposed in the PVD (as well as at the various RTAs, which are also being endorsed copy of this communication for necessary action accordingly).

As far as specific terms and conditions mentioned by you (or otherwise) are concerned, I am directed to inform you that :

- a) RTAs have already been allowed to issue 3 region permits (as decided in a meeting of the STA on 20-11-2012)
- b) As further decided by the STA in the aforesaid meeting on 20-11-2012, the relevant contract carriage permit will be issued by the RTAs in whose jurisdiction the vehicle is registered and the starting point lies.
- c) There will be a ban on use of soft-top vehicles on safety concerns of school children and as such no vehicle can be permitted with soft tops.

I am accordingly directed to request you to kindly take necessary steps in the above context and keep this Department posted with the action taken for information of the State Road Safety Council (SRSC) in its meeting.

Registering authority will collect information of all pending cases and examine various phases to avoid bottlenecks, if any.

SCENARIO 1 – conversion process completed, but permits not issued. Issue permits after fees have been realised.

SCENARIO 2 – conversion process incomplete due to non-payment of taxes. Tax adjustments may be made, if applied for, and conversions may be completed. In case where further taxes are required to be realised, the applicant should be asked to pay the assessed tax immediately.

SCENARIO 3 – offer latter is issued, further process not been followed by applicant. The matter should be disposed, provided that the vehicles is not older than 10 years. In such cases permits may be issued post conversion of vehicles with payment of token fine.

SCENARIO 4 – offer latter is issued by RTA, Kolkata, but the vehicles are registered elsewhere. The applicant may opt for change of address of vehicles as per rule along with application for conversion of vehicle at Kolkata. In other cases, RTA, Kolkata will forward all such cases to the respective RTAs for consideration.

All concerned are directed to act in accordance with the above.

MEMORANDUM

Federation of West Bengal Truck Operators' Associations vide their letter no. FWBTOA/19/2015 dated-23.04.2015 has brought to the notice of the Government a few issues that require to be addressed for smooth movement of trucks across the State. The State Government, after due consideration of the issues hereby impress upon all concerned the need for affirmative steps to address the issues mentioned below in the manner suggested against each.

Enforcement***

Issues

- (a) Use of reflectors:- Registering Authorities are required to ensure that only certified materials (AIS: 090-2005) of high quality are used without any brand fixation.
- (b) Transfer of ownership of change of address: Stipulations contained in this Department's No. 1643-WT/3M-38/2013 dated-26.04.2013 should be strictly followed by the Registering Authorities and action taken in a time-bound manner.
- (c) Overloading of vehicles:- All district and Sub-Divisional authorities should strictly follow the guidelines contained in this Department's memo no. 4220-WT/3M-128/97 dated-25.11.2013 read with Notification no. 4324-WT/3M-128/97 dated-28.10.2014. Police Authorities are required to act in tandem with the civil administration in a focused manner in order to achieve the purpose of the aforementioned Government Orders in letter and spirit.
- (d) NOC from financiers:- Registering Authorities are required to act in terms of the provisions of section 51(6) of the M.V. Act, 1988 only, but in cases where NOC is not available on time provisions of sub-sections (7), (8) and (9) ibid should be applied wherever necessary for speedy disposal of the relevant applications.

Ref:-This office letter no. 3630(20)-WT/3M-128/97 dated-27.09.2013

Sir,

With reference to the letter noted above, it is informed that Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Government of India has repeatedly requested the state government to take suitable actions as per law by the enforcement authorities to prevent the practice of overloading of goods vehicles. Accordingly this department has also advised the district authorities several times in the past to organize special drives for this purpose and to send action taken report periodically.

Now in the light of the serious damage of the roads caused by plying of overloaded goods-vehicles and resultant increase in the cost of regular maintenance of roads in this state, the government requires to take immediate and serious drives to stop the practice of overloading in this state through rigorous and continuous enforcement activities.

The Transport Department has already placed 78 Motor Vehicle Inspectors, Technical and Non-Technical, inducted under contractual basis with the concurrence of Finance Department, in different the MV Offices to enhance the man-power. One of the main reasons behind this augmentation of manpower relates to subject at hand.

Accordingly you are requested to take the following actions:-

1. Regular enforcement raids are to be conducted almost on all days on all major roads in the district covering the maximum period of time. For this purpose 2 (Two) separate teams of MV Enforcement Wing with regular MVIs, assisted by contractual MVIs and CD Volunteers, may be engaged every-day. RTO/ARTO should supervise the raids personally at regular interval.
2. Existing weigh-bridges on NHs and SHs, preferably at the points where enough space for detaining vehicles is available, are to be selected as checking points. Charges for weighing are to be paid by the owner/driver of the vehicle in charge in terms of Rule 287(2) (a) of WBMV Rules, 1989.
3. Off-loading of the load in excess of capacity at the risk of the owner/driver of the vehicle must be ensured before the vehicle is allowed to move further after detention. Off-loading is mandatory as directed by the apex court of the country.
4. Compounding of the offences committed under section 200 of MV Act, 1988 may be done before a vehicle is allowed to move only after off-loading of excess load.
5. Action may be taken under clause (a) of sub-section (1) of section 86 of MV Act, 1988 to cancel or suspend the permit, or to realize any appropriate sum from the permit holder as per provision of sub-section (6) of section 86 in lieu of cancellation/suspension of permit for committing the offence.
6. Ensure listing of major goods vehicle loading points, premises, factories, ghats, mines, godowns etc, for enduring raids/inspections to take necessary action taken under clause section 199 of MV Act, 1988 to penalize companies or firms for excess loading in their business premise (s).

Necessary co-ordination with the neighbouring district may be made to plan the enforcement/raid programmes in such manner that the major roads are covered by different enforcement teams at any point of time of a day.

Also, Superintendent of Police may be requested to provide necessary support to the enforcement team for conducting such raids regularly while ensuring safety and security of enforcement team.

DMs are requested to ensure that an action taken report after every fortnight is sent to this department.

It has been brought to the notice of the Government that the orders issued by the Government from time to time including the one vide no. 2428-WT/3M-65/2010 (Part-I) dated-29.06.2015 in the matter of elimination/prevention of overloading of vehicle in the State should be more strictly followed. A State Task Force (STF) constituted vide no. 4091-WT/3M-128/97 dated-29.06.2014 specifically for the purpose enforcing the Government Orders in tandem with the Police Authorities at various levels also appears to be needing more manpower resources and infrastructures.

Now, after due consideration of all the relevant factors and views of different stakeholders associated with the goods carriage transportation sector, it has been decided to reinforce the steps already taken by the Government in order to eliminate the acts of overloading of vehicles through the set of measures as detailed below:

MEASURES

1. Enforcement raids by the competent authorities should be conducted on a regular basis with specific focus on overloading, and any attempt to evade taxes should be strictly dealt with.
2. In cases where overloading vehicles are sighted/detected, action should be taken for off-loading all the overloaded vehicles by the owner(s)/driver concerned at their own risk and responsibility in terms of the provision of section 114 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 followed by strict action as per extant order.
3. About thirty (30) Motor Vehicle Inspectors are being marked for prevention of overloading and manning the Check post: these MVIs will be placed at the disposal of the districts concerned (vide separate orders? And shall be responsible for strictly enforcing the Government Orders and provisions of law to ensure complete elimination of overloading of vehicles under the guidance and central operational control of the STF.
4. It shall be the responsibility of the STF to deploy of MVIs earmarked for the purpose in the four (4) temporary check post (in addition to the Border Check Post at Rampur (Dist-

Burdwan), Belata (Dist-Paschim Medinipore) Srirampur and Boxirhat (Dist-Coochbehar) so that the intersections of important National/State Highways can be adequately covered for the purpose of enforcement of total elimination of overloading of vehicles. The said four (4) temporary check posts will now be at/near: Dhulagarh (in the district Paschim Medinipur) ; and Palsanda (in the district of Murshidabad)

5. STF should identify the exact points at the above temporary check post locations/sites where the MVIs will be deployed for discharging their responsibilities in the matter of prevention of overloading; facilities for temporary detention of vehicles, offloading besides weighing facilities should also be put in place. The list of the places so identified should be sent to the Government in the Transport Department for further action.
6. District Magistrate concerned in consultation with the Police Authorities in the district should work out specific action plan in the matter of enforcing orders for complete elimination of overloading of vehicle in their respective jurisdiction; while doing so, it shall be ensured that the Check posts and temporary check posts put into operation are fully utilized for the purpose without counter-productive and erratic check posts put into operation are fully utilized for the purpose without counter-productive and erratic dispersal of resources-civil or police-in other places in keeping with the basis spirit of the order issued by this Department vide no. 2428-WT/3M-65/2010 (Part-I) dated-29.06.2015
7. Strict enforcement of the provisions of the Carriage by Road Act, 2007 and Rules made thereunder shall be ensured in terms of the directions issued by this Department from time to time.
8. Wide publicity campaign/awareness drive should be carried out by the district authorities against the illegality/public hazards of the movement of overloading vehicles on roads in order to ensure complete road safety.

It is re-emphasized that detailed report on enforcement measures as aforementioned should be sent to this Department once in a fortnight in the enclosed format marked Annexure-I

In this regard the Transport Department has also empowered certain police officers vide Notification No.4324-WT/3M-128/97 dated 28.10.2014 to take action against the offending vehicles detected for violating the provisions of section 113 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and refer the cases to the nearest RTO/ARTO for taking appropriate action under section 114 of the Act. Police officers have also been empowered to compound offences under different sections of the Act vide Notification No.3205-WT/3M-15/2007 dated 30.06.2007.

3. In this regard, it has to be ensured that MVIs are made available to the concerned Commissioners/Superintendents of Police on regular basis for the purpose of taking lawful action under section 114 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.

4. Hence, to ensure proper coordination and expeditious actions you are requested to:

- a) Ensure that Motor Vehicles Inspectors are attached with the concerned Police-stations under your jurisdiction.
- b) Issue necessary orders on tagging of MVIs with the concerned police stations etc. in consultation with the Commissioner of Police/Superintendent of Police in the district immediately.
- c) A copy of the order should also be sent to the undersigned.

NOTIFICATION

The issue of operation of Maxicab as Stage Carriage, particularly in the newly constructed roads under the Pradhan Mantri Gramin sarak Yojana (PMGSY) Scheme, with a view to catering the need of the travelling rural people in the concerned areas, has been a great concern of the Government for sometime past.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of section 67 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988) and in supersession of all orders / directions etc. issued in the matter of allowing Maxi-cabs / Small passenger vehicles / Trekkers etc. as Stage Carriage, the Governor is pleased hereby to issue, with immediate effect, the following directions to all regional Transport Authorities in the State, in the matter of granting Stage Carriage permits to the Maxi-cabs / Small passenger vehicles / Trekkers in the districts, in the interest of travelling rural people :-

DIRECTIONS

- 1) The total route length of any such route shall not exceed 30 kms in general
- 2) The route shall lie within the jurisdiction of the permit issuing Regional Transport Authorities (RTA) only i.e. Intra District permit.
- 3) Such route shall not fall within the jurisdiction of Kolkata city and Suburban areas.
- 4) Such route shall not traverse along National Highways except crossing at recognised points.
- 5) Such stage Carriage permits may be on existing bus route.
- 6) The plying of such Maxi-cabs / Small passenger vehicles / Trekkers shall be restricted up to a stretch of maximum 5 kms. on the State Highways.
- 7) Such Stage Carriage permits shall be issued -
 - (a) maximum of 100, in case of districts of Howrah, Dakshin Dinajpur, Darjeeling, Uttar Dinagpur, Hooghly, Malda, Birbhum, Purulia, Bankura, Coochbihar and
 - (b) maximum of 200, in case of districts of Murshidabad, Jalpaiguri, Burdwan, Paschim Medinipur, Purba Medinipur, South 24 Parganas, North 24 Parganas, Nadia.

AND WHEREAS the Government of West Bengal in the Transport Department has considered the entire report and decided to accept the recommendations of the said Committee for better control of traffic congestion and reduction in automobile pollution in the city of Kolkata in the interest of citizens.

NOW THEREFORE in compliance of the aforesaid order of the Hon'ble High Court and in pursuance to the powers vested upon the State Government as per provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act and Rules framed thereunder, the Governor is hereby pleased to direct the State Transport authority, West Bengal and all the Regional Transport authorities in the state, that :-

1. No new bus route be formulated and permits be issued which may pass through the Central Business District viz. Esplanade and Band Stand in Kolkata and Howrah Station and approach areas of Howrah Bridge (Rabindra Setu) till further orders.
2. No new permit for Stage Carriage shall be issued which may originate / terminate in Esplanade and Band Stand in Kolkata and Howrah Station.

3. No new bus route shall also be created / formulated in Kolkata and Howrah without creating any appropriate parking place having requisite amenities for both the passengers as well as the transport workers.

4. No new permit shall be issued for autorickshaw operating within Kolkata Metropolitan area.

This order shall take immediate effect.

AND WHEREAS as per West Bengal Motor vehicles Rules, 1989 Kolkata means “the town of [Kolkata] as defined in Section 3 of the [Kolkata] police Act, 1886 (Ben. Act IV of 1866). Together with the suburbs of [Kolkata] as defined under Section 1 of the [Kolkata] Suburban police Act, 1986 and shall also include Police Stations of Salt Lake and Lake Town under West Bengal Police;

AND WHEREAS in some of the cases the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta had observed that “no material is produced before this Court to show that there is any restriction to ply Bharat stage - III compliant vehicle on particular route and allowed replacement on route with Bharat stage - III compliant vehicle and there is demand to consider Inter- regional Stage Carriage permits within West Bengal be treated at par with Inter- State routes as these are generally long distance routes;

AND WHEREAS the Environment Department, Government of West Bengal clarified that no orders relating to applicability of Bharat Stage- IV Emission norms have been issued either by the Environment

ORDER

Sub : Guideline for registration & permit of any vehicles

In recent past several representations have been received by this department from various organizations, owners and operators of operators of deferent categories of vehicles regarding the problems faced by them and registering their vehicles or in getting endorsement of change of address or in recording transfer of ownership of any vehicles as well as issuance or renewal of any permit resulting in seriously delays and harassment in different M.V. Offices in the state.

After careful consideration of all the problems in the light of the corresponding provisions of M.V. Act 1988 and rule made there under as well as the notifications, orders and instructions issued by the Central Government and the State Government in the such matters from time to time it has been decided by the transport department to review the related procedure with a view to remove all the preventing confusions.

The followings guidelines are to be followed by the concern authorities to be followed for registration of vehicles and issuance of permits.

A. REGISTRATION & ALLIED TRANSACTIONS:

(I) JURISDICTION OF REGISTRATION :

In terms of section 40 of MV Act any vehicles can be registered (new or CA case) with the registering authority under whose jurisdiction the owner has his residential address or his business address. Production of proof for address is mandatory. In cases where the temporary and the permanent address are deferent that the owner can also opt to apply at the office of the registering authority where his temporary address lies.

WHEREAS section 69 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 provides that "if it is proposed to use the vehicle or vehicles in two or more regions lying within the same State, the application shall be made to the Regional Transport Authority of the region in which the major portion of the proposed route or area lies and in case the portion of proposed route or area in each of the region is approximately equal, to the Regional Transport Authority of the region in which it is proposed to keep the vehicle or vehicles."

AND WHEREAS there has nonetheless been a practice in West Bengal that the State Transport Authority is used to process applications for permits for vehicles in more than two regions within the same state.

AND WHEREAS, the law is very clear that a Regional Transport Authority may process applications for permits for vehicles in more than two regions also.

NOW, THEREFORE the Governor is pleased to direct that, henceforth in cancellation of all earlier orders published by the Transport Department, Government of West Bengal and practices in this regard, applications for permits for all kinds of vehicles that would ply in three regions lying within the same State will be made to the Regional Transport Authority of the region in which the major portion of the proposed route or area lies, and in case the portion of the proposed route or area in each of the regions is approximately equal, to the Regional Transport Authority of the region in which it is proposed to keep the vehicle or vehicles.

This order is issued after obtaining legal opinion and after careful consideration of a similar resolution adopted by the State Transport Authority, West Bengal under Misc. Agenda No.-4 in its meeting dated 21-02-2013.

Oviously, the Regional Transport Authorities will abide by the lawfully imposed and jurisdiction upheld restrictions with regard to areas where permits can not be allowed or where vehicles can not originate / terminate / pass through.

You may, however, send specific proposals, including copies of the relevant resolution of the RTA, for issue of notification with regard to the formulation of new "**CITY ROUTES**", if any, and/or enhancement of fleet strength of existing "**CITY ROUTES**" within the scope and ambit of section 71(3)(a) bid having regard to the number of vehicles, road conditions and other relevant matters without disrupting the exist routes, so notified, unduly. The cases of variation / extension or curtailment of existing routes are to be dealt with by the concerned RTA only in terms of section 72(2) (xxii) and section 80(3) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.

B) TRANSPORT VEHICLE

- i. If the residential / business address of the owner is within Kolkata, no vehicle less then BS-III compliant vehicle will be allowed, subject restriction on playing in Kolkata.
- ii. If the residential / business address of the owner is outside of Kolkata, no vehicle lesser then BS-II compliant vehicle will be allowed, subject restriction of playing in Kolkata / KMA, as the case may be.

Provided that, in case of vehicles already registered and the change of address occurs within that registering authority, then such change is allowed subject to the life of any transport vehicle so registered in Kolkata metropolitan area is less than 15 years.

IV. TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF VEHICLE:

- a) In case of any vehicle already registered in any region, transfer of ownership within the region is to be allowed irrespective of BS-norms subject to the condition that in case of any transport vehicle registered in KMA the age of the vehicle is less than 15 years. in case of transfer of transport vehicle, the existing permit is to be surrendered by the permit holder unless he has obtained any replacement order against the vehicle. New permit is to be issued to that vehicle as per section 80 of the M.V 1988 except in cases where transfer of permit is allo wed by the concerned RTA OR STA.
- b) In case of vehicle already registered in any region, transfer of ownership to any purchaser, having business address in the same region but willing to get that vehicle registered in any other region having jurisdiction in which the purchaser has his residence is to be allowed by the existing RA with the concerned issuance of NOC to that other region. Existing permit is to be surrendered by transferor, unless he has obtained any replacement order. New permit is to be issued to that vehicle as per section 80 of M.V Act 1988 by the RTA of other region.

V. PERMIT - ISSUANCE, RENEWAL AND REPLACEMENT :

- a) The basic policy of liberalization in issuance of permits to transport vehicles in the interest of public maintaining the provision of M.V Act & Rules made there under restriction on use of vehicles in any region based on prevailing pollution norms, otherwise should be clearly endorsed on the permit positively.
- b) New permit is to be issued to a transport vehicle registered in any region incompliance of above guideline subject to compliance of the related provision of M.V. Act & Rule made there under restriction on use of vehicle in any region based on prevailing pollution norms or other wise, should be clerly endorsed on the permit positively.
- c) Renewal of any existing permit is to be allowed, subject to restriction on use of 15 – years old vehicle. As imposed in the order issued by the transport department under No. 2827-WT/ 3M/-86/2009 dated 13/08/2012, and other conditions. Such as replacement to be made within a specified period, imposed by RTA.
- d) Replacement of vehicle by higher model vehicle of similar technical specification of the existing vehicle is to be allowed in term of Rule 153 of WBMVR 1989 subject to decision of RTA.

All concerned authorities are directed to take necessary action for speedy disposal of applications on the above-noted issues including all pending cases following the above guidelines.

Ref : Your letter Nos 894/Con(G) dated 24-10-2013, T-16014/5/2013-MV/91547, dated 12-11-2013 & T-12011/5/2013-MV/93568, dated 12-12-2013.

SIR,

This has reference to your letters mentioned above, whereby you have sought enhancement of feelt strength in the route DN-44 while expressing your inability to issue new auto rickshaw and maxi-cab permits in KMA due to restrictions under notification no. 3438-WT/3M-139/2004, dated 02-08-2004.

In this context, I would like to invite your attention to the scope and ambit of section 71(3)(a) of the Motor Vehicles Act 1988, whereby it has been stipulated that the State Government shall limit humber of stage carriages generally or of any specified type operating on “**CITY ROUTES**” in towns having population not less than 5 lakhs. Thus according to the statutory provisions, such limitation does not apply to any other routes.

Further, your attention is also invited to the recent notification No. 4111-WT/3M-88/2003 dated 14-11-2013 (copy enclosed), whereby the issue has been dealt with adequately and the stumbling blocks, if any, were removed to an extent.

Therefore, you are requested to dispose the applications in accordance with the above notification. However, the restrictions related to auto rickshaws in KMA shall remain operative until further orders.

WHEREAS the Government of India has, from time to time issued direction to the State Government [in terms of the aforesaid section 71(3)(a) above] asking the State Government to fix and specify and notify the fleet strength on the city routes in given towns accordingly.

WHEREAS the directions of the Government of India have occasionally mentioned the names of the Districts in general also, which are affected in the process, though, obviously, such mention of the names of the District have to be read in the context of section 71(3)(a) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.

WHEREAS there is no power of any authority at the Central or State or Regional Level to impose any ceiling on the strength of any route other than city routes in towns with a population of not less than five lakhs.

WHEREAS the position above has been upheld by the Hon'ble High Court in a number of cases.

NOW THEREFORE, it is accordingly decided after obtaining a further legal opinion, that the Regional Transport Authorities and/or the District Magistrate will not be required to refer the issues of fixation of route strength to the State Government in case of any route other than "city routes in towns with a population of not less than five lakhs".

It is clarified that if there exists any Notification in the State or District Level Fixing Ceiling on the number of stage carriages on any route in the State except in the city routes in towns with a population of not less than five lakhs, then the aforesaid fixation on the fleet strength of such routes henceforth will stand cancelled and superseded by this notification.

This will take immediate effect.

I have been directed to inform you that in meeting held by Honourable MIC, Transport Department in the presence of different stakeholders, including yourselves, it was decided that new permits for a limited number of metered taxis of both AC and non AC varieties may be issued by the concerned RTAs as per following details :-

2. I am further directed to inform you that the Government in transport Department intends to grant permission to above mentioned RTAs to issue the new permits for metered taxis provided proposal is considered by the concerned RTA Board and resolved so. Proposal from Chairman of concerned RTA along with copy of such resolution may be sent to Transport Department so that enabling Government order can be issued in this regard.
3. Terms and conditions for allowing such new permits for metered taxis shall be as per the followings :—
 - i) All such new metered taxis shall be BS-IV complaint and sedan type of vehicles only;
 - ii) All these taxis will be of blue & white colour combination bearing "No Refusal" logo;
 - iii) All these new metered taxis must be fitted with approved fare meters with approved printing facility and calibrated as per current approved fare rates for non AC metered taxis only. The

AC metered taxis however will charge an additional 25% on the fare shown in the meter;

- iv) All such metered taxis new permits shall be fitted with GPS / GPRS based navigational and location indicating devices showing the route of the proposed journey in real time including the location for the convenience of the passenger / the driver, and, also for location based vehicle tracking system.
- v) The seating capacity of all such motor cabs shall be limited to 4+1 only and there will be no bar on any make or model of vehicle, while the minimum engine capacities of the vehicles shall be 1050 cc and 1150 cc for the non AC and AC metered taxis respectively.
- vi) Value added services i.e. two news papers (one each in Bengali and English vernacular) and music system, shall be made available in all new AC metered taxis at no extra cost;
- vii) Selection of operators for both AC and non AC metered taxis should be done strictly on merit as per Section 74(3)(b) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.
- viii) Each applicant shall submit an affidavit, sworn on non judicial stamp paper before a Magistrate or Notary Public along with the application for permits to the effect that he would abide by all the conditions mentioned in this letter and further undertaking that operation of the vehicle shall not be stopped due to any call of strike, bandh, Hartal etc. on any day and further to the effect that there shall be no refusal to accept passenger on hire by the driver while driving the vehicle at any place and at any time of the day and night. This may be an additional condition of the permit so issued.
- ix) Fare rates for both AC and non AC, as may be applicable, including night time additional charges shall apply. However, the passenger shall have a choice of using or not using the AC in an AC metered taxi and the fare should be charged accordingly depending on the actual nature of use.

Whereas, reports were received from the different stakeholders by the Transport Department, regarding operation of unauthorized auto-rickshaws plying on many of the routes falling within the jurisdiction of Regional Transport Authority (hereinafter referred as RTA), Kolkata without having proper insurance certificate, registration certificate, tax receipt, permit and pollution under control certificate, as is required under the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Act of 59 of 1988) and Rules made thereunder;

AND Whereas, the Government is deeply concerned about the safety and security of the passengers, travelling on such unauthorized auto-rickshaws, and their difficulties in getting legal assistance in case of any accident;

AND Whereas, considering all these aspects the Governor was pleased to form a High Power Committee on Auto-rickshaw vide Notification No. 5444-WT/3M-01/2010 dated 02.12.2016 for considering the proposals of regularization of unauthorised auto-rickshaws presently plying on roads on 'as is where is' basis, as well as, for issuance of fresh autorickshaw permits within the jurisdiction of RTA, Kolkata and other related matters;

AND Whereas, the said High Power Committee on Auto-rickshaw submitted their report vide Memo. No. 94/T. Dte/Auto-Report dated 31.10.2017 after considering the objections and/or suggestions of the stake holders along with the facts and figures on plying of auto-rickshaws (including unauthorized autorickshaws) from the concerned RTAs having jurisdiction over Kolkata, Howrah, Bidhannagar and Barrackpore Police Commissionerates (before extension of the jurisdiction of RTA, Kolkata vide notification No. 3838-WT/3M-51/2010 dated 03.10.2016) and also from the Traffic Wings of Kolkata, Howrah, Bidhannagar and Barrackpore Police Commissionerates;

AND Whereas, after examining the said report of the High Power Committee on Auto-rickshaw and upon considering its recommendations, it was decided by the Transport Department to regularize the unauthorized auto-rickshaws presently plying on the city-routes in Kolkata on 'as is where is' basis. Accordingly, a draft notification was published vide notification No. 2543-WT/3M-01/2010 (Pt.II) dated 11.06.2018, to limit the number of permits on auto-rickshaw within the present jurisdiction of RTA, Kolkata upon supersession of all earlier notifications in this regard and to seek representations, suggestions and/or objections, if any, from all the stake-holders before finalizing such notification;

AND Whereas, this Department received number of representations, suggestions and objections from the stakeholders which were finally examined, considered and disposed by a Committee again constituted for that purpose vide notification No. 3416-WT/3M-01/2010(Pt.II) dated 25.07.2018 and the said Committee submitted its report and recommendations vide Memo. No. C-4/RTA/18(T.Dte)/Auto Com (Clm&Obj) dated 14.09.2018 and Memo. No. 256/T.Dte/Auto-Rickshaws/2018 dated 28.11.2018.

However, regularization of unauthorized auto-rickshaws presently plying within the jurisdiction of RTA, Kolkata continuously since 01.01.2015 or before shall be done by RTA, Kolkata on 'as is where is basis' by issuing fresh permits on autorickshaw within the abovementioned notified maximum limit in accordance with the "Auto-rickshaw Policy of West Bengal, 2018" issued by the Transport Department, Government of West Bengal vide notification No.3944-WT/3M-01/2010 Pt.-II dated 14.08.2018.

All the existing unauthorized auto-rickshaws plying continuously since 01.01.2015 or before within the jurisdiction of RTA, Kolkata, shall be given the opportunity to avail 'one-time regularization' process on 'as is where is' basis within the prescribed time limit under certain terms and conditions mentioned in the said policy.

The Government in the Transport Department shall only be competent to alter or modify this notification from time to time, if so considered necessary in public interest.

WHEREAS the Government of West Bengal in the Transport Department maintains a Central Pool Car Office for catering to the vehicular needs of visiting VVIPs (including The President of India, The Prime Minister of India, Union Cabinet Ministers, Judges of Supreme Court, Governors or Lieutenant Governors of other States and many other State Guests etc., as the case may be) as well as to the vehicular needs of the Hon'ble Public Functionaries of the state.

WHEREAS there have been occasions and situations where the requirements of the visiting VVIPs and guests and the needs of the State functionaries enjoying support of pool car system collide.

WHEREAS the Pool Car Office during those occasions have often attempted to tide over the demand and supply mis-match by trying to hire (Often by flat) from the market vehicles that could be part of VVIPs conveys.

WHEREAS such short-notice hiring often proves to be a difficult exercise with hiring agencies showing, more frequently than not, recalcitrance.

WHEREAS vehicles suddenly hired from the streets of Kolkata are not always suitable (from different points of view including security angle) in VVIPs / VIPs' convoys.

WHEREAS the State Government has been engaged on this question for some time now and has been noticing that some Hon'ble Ministers in the State have been meanwhile choosing to use hired vehicles rather than depending on the vehicles supplied by the Pool Car office.

NOTIFICATION

Whereas the process for regularization of unauthorized auto-rickshaws was to be completed by 31st December, 2018 in terms of the 'Auto-rickshaw Policy of West Bengal, 2018' as notified vide No. 3944-WT/3M-01/2010 Pt. II dated 14.08.2018; and

Whereas the list of routes and maximum number of permits for auto-rickshaws operable within the jurisdiction of Regional Transport Authority, Kolkata was finally notified afresh by the Transport Department in terms of Section 74(3) of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 vide notification No. 5673-WT/3M-01/2010 Pt. II dated 10.12.2018 leaving not enough time for completion of such regularization within the stipulated date;

Now, therefore, in order to provide sufficient time for completion of the said process of regularization, the Governor is hereby pleased to extend the last date upto **28th February, 2019** until further order.

Also in terms of clause (i) and (j) of item I of the Auto-rickshaw Policy of West Bengal, 2018 mentioned above the Governor is pleased to specify the colour code of auto-rickshaws operating in the jurisdictions of different Regional Transport Authorities in the following manner:

a) For auto-rickshaws operating in the jurisdiction of Regional Transport Authority, Kolkata (areas under Kolkata, Howrah, Bidhan Nagar and Barrackpore Police Commissionerates):

The existing colour code shall continue with additional feature of one yellow ring of 8" diameter having a white circle of 6" diameter inside it on the front left fender. The name of the R.T.A. issuing the permit is to be inscribed on the yellow ring and the 'Permit No.' and the 'Route No.' are to be inscribed in two parts (upper & lower) of the white circle. All the inscriptions are to be made in blue.

b) For auto-rickshaws operating the areas outside the jurisdiction of Regional Transport Authority, Kolkata:

The existing colour code shall continue with additional feature of one white band (width 4") around the body with a blue ribbon (width 1") at the middle of the band. At rear part on the left side, one white ring of 8" diameter containing a yellow circle of 6" diameter inside it is to be inscribed upon the band. The name of the R.T.A. issuing the permit is to be inscribed on the white ring and the 'Permit No.' and the 'Route No.' are to be inscribed in two parts (upper & lower) of the yellow circle. All the inscriptions are to be made in blue.

In both the cases the additional markings shall be inscribed by painting only and it shall not be in the form of removable stickers.

1. The rate of hiring as shown above is the maximum rate at which a vehicle may be hired, there is no bar in hiring a vehicle at a rate lower than the ceiling of rates as shown above.
2. Revised rates of hiring charges of above stated category of vehicles for casual hiring should be fixed either on the basis of Kilometers covered or on the basis of hours of use of vehicle whichever is higher subject to the minimum charges as prescribed in the Schedule,
3. Maximum 10 Kilometer between the garage of the vehicle and the place of reporting or one hour's hiring charge (both way inclusive) whichever is convenient to the owner of the vehicle may be allowed.
4. Only transport vehicle having valid Contract Carriage permit can be placed on hire.
5. In case of hiring of a vehicle for more than 10 days in a month or hiring of vehicles in a regular manner the rate hiring should be on monthly rate on pro-rata basis.
6. Vehicle to be hired by Government Department / Offices shall require prior concurrence of Finance Department as usual. Express permission of the Finance Department shall also be required for hiring of vehicle the categories of other than Non-Air-Conditioned Motor Cab and Maruti Omni Petrol driven vehicle should not be hired by Government Departments without the approval of the Financial Department
